# **USEFUL INFO**

### CLASSES

#### Lesson Length: 50 minutes

Max. Class Size: 15

#### **Minimum Level Requirements:**

- **GE20:** A1 Elementary (We do not have courses for absolute beginners. Students should have a basic knowledge of English. We may not be able to accommodate complete beginner students in our classes.)
- IELTS20 / FCE20: B2 Upper-Intermediate
- CAE20: C1 Advanced

#### Number of GE26 Plus Class Lessons per Week:

- 3 or more students in the class: 6 lessons per week
- 2 students in the class: 4 lessons per week
- 1 students in the class: 2 lessons per week

#### **COURSE BOOK POLICY**

All students registered for a course are required to have the coursebook for their class. At the start of a new term or when students change level part-way through a term, they must buy a copy of the coursebook used at the level they are moving to.

Students can start their course any week throughout the year. However, please note that *it is recommended not to start a course during the last two weeks of a term* but with the start of the new term.

#### **BANK HOLIDAYS 2024**

#### DUBLIN:

New Year's Day (01 January), St. Brigid's Day (05 February), St. Patrick's Day (17 March), Good Friday\* (29 March), Easter Monday (01 April), May Day (06 May), June Bank Holiday (03 June), August Bank Holiday (05 August), October Bank Holiday (28 October), Christmas Day (25 December), and St. Stephen's Day (26 December)

\* Good Friday is not a public holiday in Ireland, though like many schools and businesses we are closed on that day for a long Easter weekend.

#### MALTA:

New Year's Day (01 January), Feast of St Paul's Shipwreck (10 February), Feast of St Joseph (19 March), Good Friday (29 March), Freedom Day (31 March), Workers' Day (01 May), Sette Giugno (07 June), Feast of St Peter and St Paul (29 June), Feast of the Assumption (15 August), Victory Day (08 September), Independence Day (21 September), Immaculate Conception (08 December), Republic Day (13 December), Christmas Day (25 December)

Please note that our schools are closed on bank holidays and it is not possible to compensate for bank holidays.

#### PAYMENT

All course fees should be paid in full at least 30 days prior to the student commencing their course.

## **COURSE CANCELLATION**

Courses are not transferable. Tuition fees are non-refundable once a student has commenced their course. If a student cancels their course more than 30 days before the course commences, all fees will be refunded.

If a student cancels their course less than 30 days before the course commences, fees will be refunded with the exception of the registration fee (€70).

#### ACCOMMODATION CANCELLATION

#### HOMESTAY

#### Pre-Arrival:

- 1. If homestay accommodation is cancelled more than 30 days before arrival, all accommodation fees will be refunded.
- 2. If homestay accommodation is cancelled less than 30 days but more than 7 days before arrival, all accommodation fees will be refunded with the exception of the accommodation placement (€70).
- 3. If homestay accommodation is cancelled less than 7 days before arrival, all accommodation fees will be refunded with the exception of the accommodation placement fee (€70) and one week's accommodation.
- 4. If homestay accommodation is postponed less than 7 days before arrival, the student will be charged for one week's accommodation. For students starting in the first week of January, all changes must be done at least 7 days before the winter holidays start, otherwise this penalty will be charged accordingly.

#### **Post-Arival:**

1. The first 4 weeks of a host family booking cannot be cancelled. After that a booked host family stay can be cancelled if the school receives notification 2 weeks in advance. A refund can be given for the outstanding weeks that the family was booked for.

#### RESIDENCE

#### Pre-Arrival:

- 1. If residential accommodation is cancelled more than 30 days before arrival, all accommodation fees will be refunded.
- 2. If residential accommodation is cancelled less than 30 days but more 14 days before arrival, all accommodation fees will be refunded with the exception of the accommodation placement fee (€70).
- 3. If residential accommodation is cancelled less than 14 days before arrival, all accommodation fees will be refunded with the exception of the accommodation placement fee (€70) and one week's accommodation.
- 4. No refund will be made if a student makes alternative arrangements during their stay.
- 5. No allowance will be made for absence from accommodation during the time arranged or for late arrival or early departure (including postponement).
- 6. If residential accommodation is postponed less than 14 days before arrival, the student will be charged for one week's accommodation. For students starting in the first week of January, all changes must be done at least 7 days before the winter holidays start, otherwise this penalty will be charged accordingly.

#### **Post-Arrival:**

Residence accommodation fees are generally non-refundable once a student has arrived at the accommodation.
